

Special Weekend

Among the islands of the Gulf.

Departure from Castellammare di Stabia on Friday at 4.00 p.m. towards Ischia. Dinner on board, moored in harbour. On Saturday morning tour of the island to admire the Aragonese Castle, the Bay of Casamicciola, Forio, Cetara, Sant'Angelo, Maronti. Lunch on board and disembarkement to visit the island. Dinner on board.

On Sunday morning departure towards Capri, disembarkement to visit the island. Lunch on board, circumnavigation of Capri to admire the stacks, the natural arch and the Azzurra Grotto. Return to Castellammare foreseen at 6.00 p.m.

Departure sailing along the Sorrento coast, and arrival to Capri. Dinner on board, with ship moored in harbour.

On Saturday morning departure towards Amalfi, admiring the natural reserve of Punta Campanella and the island of Galli. Arrival at Amalfi and visit of the marvellous town with the thick plain of little

streets dominated by the majestic Cathedral, masterpiece of the romanic architecture, and tour of the Valley of Mulini, with the ancient Papermills, whose precious production can be admired in the Museum of the Paper. Dinner on board.

On Sunday departure towards Positano, smart centre where it is possible to join the charming weather and the nature, walking among small roads crowded with shops, or relaxing in elegant cafés on the beaches.

Lunch on board and return to Castellammare di Stabia foreseen at about 6.00 p.m.

A still uncontaminated Paradise

Departure from Salerno on Friday at 4.00 p.m. towards Paestum. Dinner on board, with ship moored in harbour. On Saturday morning guided visit to Paestum's escaves; Paestum, built by the Greeks, keeps very well the ancient urbanistic style, with the remainings of the principal buildings, while the Museum keeps pieces of great interest, among which the fresco graves of the so-called *Diver's Tomb (Tomba del Tuffatore)*. The presence of the

monumental temples of Cerere and Poseidon, among the greatest examples of Greek architecture, and the showing of the extremely rich Museum, make Paestum an archeological site of world wide importance.

Lunch on board and departure towards Punta Licosa, through the marine park of Santa Maria. Dinner on board with ship moored in Ogliastro's Bay.

On Sunday morning sailing along Cilento's coasts, admiring the small towns of Acciaroli and Palinuro. Lunch on board and return to Salerno, foreseen at about 7.00 p.m.
